Since the last issue there has now been a new Vehicle Activate Speed Camera in the village. It is hoped that this will help to slow traffic as it approaches St. John's Road. This camera is able to be moved around the village as needed, so the location will be reviewed again in 12 months' time.

The hanging baskets were installed over the summer, and we are most grateful to Parishioners who contributed to this as it allowed us to put up more baskets than otherwise would have been possible. Feedback was really positive on the colourful display that they made through the centre of the Village and we hope to repeat this again next year.

After the Hanging Baskets came down it was soon time for the Poppies to go up and we once again put these up around the Parish, printed with the names of the fallen soldiers named on the War Memorial. For those that we know lived in Laughton, the poppies were located close to where they once lived.

The Village Hall continues to host various groups and events so please have a look at some of the regular activities overleaf. The Parish Council recently helped the Allotment Society host a Scarecrow Competition and I had the privilege of judging the best Scarecrow. There were some original and creative designs but this one caught my eye, so 'Donald Trump' has won two major contests this year!

The Parish Council will be hosting an event at the Village Hall again next year to commemorate VE day on 8th May 2025. Please save the date and keep an eye out for information nearer the time.


